When you fly into one of the 127 Wisconsin airports, you can get your Airport Passport stamped with an unique stamp for that airport. Once you reach one of the three levels, you can apply for an award given out by the Wisconsin DOT. Not only can the pilot get a passport, but their passengers can also apply for one. Each level encourages pilots and their passengers to visit all of Wisconsin airports. The also encourages you to visit one of the Wisconsin aviation museums and attend FAA safety seminars.
